First Grade suggested Supplies List 2020-2021

Below is a list of suggested first grade supplies. Please note, if we return to in-person learning, students will be asked to bring their own pencil box to and from school daily with the listed supplies below. Students will not be able to share materials with other students this year per CDC guidelines. Additionally, many families already have most of these supplies at home. Do not feel like you need to buy all the listed materials, especially, if you already have them, and/or they are optional. However, we do recommend stocking up on crayons, glue, and pencils now while prices are cheap. 😊 Lastly, additional supplies may be needed later in the year depending on what model we are in. Please let your teacher know if you need further clarification or have any questions about supplies.

At Home/Hybrid Supplies:

- Pencil Box (5" x 8")
- Bottom Pocket Folder
- No. 2 Pencils (preferably Ticonderoga)
- 1 College Ruled Spiral or Composition Notebook
- large pink eraser or eraser tops
- White Glue Sticks
- 24 Count Crayola Crayons
- Round Tip Fiskars Scissors
- 2 Expo Markers (Dark colors) Some will be in Starter Kit to begin with.
- Small Whiteboard and Whiteboard Eraser or old sock
- White Index Cards (Flash Cards)
- 1 Shoe box to store decodables
- Box, crate, or caddy to hold workbooks and supplies (Note: All supplies need to be accessible and close during Zoom meetings)

At Home Only Supplies:
